Col Smith (1908-1988) – the Deans Marsh Cricket Club was very fortunate to have had a person like Colin connected to the club for so long. The following list gives some idea of his involvement with the DMCC

- Colin began playing in the 1920's and continued until 1957 most of the time as wicket keeper. He was captain for several seasons.
- President for 56 years. At almost every annual meeting he offered to stand down but those present would not hear of it.
- He was always cheerful, friendly with everyone, and a fair player.
- Evidence of the high esteem people had for Colin was seen at his funeral in Winchelsea on the 1st November 1988. Many past cricketers, old team mates and opponents, travelled long distances to be there and join in the guard of honour at the cemetery

- Put a lot of thought into his bowling, often caught batsman out of position, a tribute to his clever flight,
- Useful opening batsman

- 400+ wickets @ average of 14.10 Best figures 19/10/7/28. Five wickets in a innings 16

Ron Millard

- Right hand batsman, Right arm slow medium bowler
- 180+ games
- 4000+ runs @ average 24.00. Highest score 118. Centuries 2. Half centuries 17
- 40 wickets @ average 19.00. Best figures 9/0/4/19

Ray (Bill) White

- Left hand batsman, Left arm slow bowler
- Best post-war batsman, scored over 10 centuries-even Bill wasn't quite sure how many. (Ron Millard)
- Perhaps his style was bit cramped but he was always aggressive and had a dynamic hook shot (Ron Millard)

- 6000+ runs @ average 27.50. Highest score 156*. Centuries 10. Half centuries 30
